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What is a Brownfield?

Real property of which the expansion, redevelopment, or reuse may be complicated by the presence or potential presence of a hazardous substance, pollutant, or contaminant. (Public Law 107-118 (H.R. 2869) - "Small Business Liability Relief and Brownfields Revitalization Act" signed into law January 11, 2002)

Brownfields in the U.S.

Estimated 450,000 to 1 Million sites

5 million acres of abandoned industrial sites in U.S. cities – roughly the same amount of land occupied by 60 of the largest U.S. cities



Why Redevelop Brownfields?

- Desirable locations
- Increases local tax base
- Improves community image
- Mitigates blight
- Mitigates public health and safety concerns

Reduce the need to develop greenfields

Uses existing infrastructure (cost savings)








Often it is the <u>PERCEPTION</u> of contamination that keeps properties from being redeveloped, not the actual presence of contamination.

BF Process


Identify the Brownfield
