

Illinois Success: Normal's Uptown Station



The centerpiece of the Uptown Plan:

- 68,000 sq/ft, LEED Silver
- Opened June 14th, 2012
- Part of a planning process that began in 1998
- Built on a Brownfield. Bus Terminal/Parking garage area was once a service station. Some contamination was found and dealt with insitu.
- One feature of an [award-winning](#) redevelopment project. Uptown is LEED ND Silver. Two other certified buildings in the project area.



Uptown Station Brings together:

- high-speed passenger rail
- intercity and local bus service
- airport shuttles
- taxi services,
- passenger vehicles
- pedestrians



It also houses municipal offices, community meeting rooms, and the Town Council Chambers...



Funding Package

- \$22 million-Transportation Investments Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) grant
- \$10.5 million - FTA's Bus and Bus Facilities grant program
- \$13.2 million - Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity and Town issued bonds.
