



Notes from the CAG

July 15, 1999

I would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone involved for their time and efforts in resolving the remediation efforts for the 57th and North Broadway Superfund Site. However, we still have some work left to do and, therefore, I am asking for just a little bit more of your time.

The Proposed Plan for the entire site was issued on July 14, 1999. As the EPA's Fact Sheet indicates, a 30 day comment period began on that date. There are several ways for you to let the EPA know what your preferred option for the clean up is. Comments can be made by phone, by letter or email, or by voicing your opinion at the Public Hearing. That Hearing will be held on July 29th and will be **YOUR LAST OPPORTUNITY** to publically voice your opinion on the Alternatives presented. Your opinion on the method of clean-up is valuable and will help to ensure that the clean-up is done quickly and effectively.

To guarantee that the public is well-informed and understands the Alternatives presented in the Proposed Plan, the Citizen's Advisory Group will hold an informational meeting on July

22nd at 7:00 p.m. at the City/County Health Department in Conference Room 1. A representative from the Great Plains/Rocky Mountain Hazardous Substance Research Center will be there to explain the Alternatives presented in the Plan by the EPA and will be available to answer your questions. The Citizen's Advisory Group is depending on you and your neighbors to make thoughtful and informed choices.

PLEASE TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE OPPORTUNITY TO LEARN ABOUT OUR CHOICES AND PLAN TO ATTEND THE MEETING ON JULY 22ND.

I look forward to seeing you on July 22nd and 29th and to a final, equitable resolution of this Superfund Site.
