ASCE Structure Profile



The Øresund or Öresund Bridge:

At 7,845 m (25,738 ft), the Oresund Bridge covers half the distance between Sweden and the Danish island of Amager. The structure has a mass of 82,000 tons and supports two railway tracks beneath four road lanes in a horizontal girder extending along the entire length of the bridge.

The construction of the Øresund Bridge began in 1995. It was finished about 1 July 2000.

Fun fact: During construction of the bridge, 16 unexploded World War II bombs were found on the sea floor.
